Draupadi Trust has been working since 2005 to enhance the Socio-economic status of Zardozi craft persons. Besides exposing them to fashion designers, the Trust also per sued with the government for Technology. Integration for improving the skill & designing opportunities for them.

After almost 2 years of interactions with the Government (MLA, DIT Ministry of Information Technology & Communication), Media Lab Asia show thus a software for embroidery design creation, with the objectives of pilot test at our center. The pilot deployment of this software CHIC – CAD was initiated at the Draupadi Trust Shahpur Jat Center in January 2011 in which 12 persons tried the software. 2 Master designers emerged out of this training of 3 months.
